# A Letter From Tim Tebow

Hey TTF Fam,

It's hard to believe we're halfway through 2025. As I reflect on the last year, I'm filled with so much gratitude for the lives that have been changed, the stories we got to witness, and for you.

Earlier this year, I had the chance to visit the TTF Protection Center in Thailand for the official grand opening. As I walked through the campus, I stepped into a counseling room—it looked like a place for healing: a small couch, dolls, children's books—a space where hope was present. But right behind the window was a wall. And on top of that wall, barbed wire.

Because the girls inside are still being pursued by their traffickers.

Kevin, a teammate walking beside me, looked out and quietly said:

**"WHAT A PICTURE OF THE THIN LINE BETWEEN TORTURED & TREASURED."**

I began to think, tears welled up in my eyes, and God just put it on my heart the meaning of those few feet of separation, and how they change everything for these girls. On the outside of the wall, these girls were trafficked, abused, and discarded. But on the inside—they are protected. They are safe. They are no longer forgotten. They are treasured.

That wall, that thin line, only exists because you helped build it. Thank you for believing that every child is worth it.

## THANK YOU FOR BEING THE THIN LINE.



Every life deserves to be celebrated, loved, and free. Around the world, millions of men, women, and children are suffering an evil they should never have to experience. At TTF, we will not slow down—in fact, in the last 365 days we chose to run further into the chaos and crisis, and bring light to so many in the darkness. Partnering with law enforcement, governments, and frontline heroes to rescue victims, confront evil, and offer healing, the impact below represents just one year of relentless pursuit to protect some of the world’s Most Vulnerable People.

By collaborating with law enforcement and partners to establish task forces, we’ve deepened our fight against human trafficking and child exploitation. We’ve strengthened our efforts to protect thousands of victims leading to:

- ▶ **1600+ IDENTIFICATIONS AND/OR RESCUES**
- ▶ **900+ OFFENDERS IDENTIFIED AND/OR ARRESTED**
- ▶ **6000+ LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINED**
- ▶ **9 UNDERCOVER OPERATIONS**

In the United States, Operation Renewed Hope III identified **386 CHILDREN & SAFEGUARDED 56 MORE.**

We committed to the expansion of Victim Identification trainings and operations in **17 LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES.**

In a bipartisan effort, we went to Congress to introduce the Renewed Hope Act of 2024 fighting for the

**50,000+ UNIDENTIFIED CHILD VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE & ONLINE EXPLOITATION.**

We continue to offer refuge, support, and restoration for survivors of trafficking and exploitation through

**45 SAFE HOMES WITH 18 MORE IN PROGRESS.**

In New York, two groundbreaking missing child rescue operations have led to the identification of

**110 CHILDREN & COUNTING.**

In the Capital District, Her Song expanded to serve even more survivors of human trafficking.

In the Philippines, we opened a transition home for survivors who are 18+ years old. This safe home will help each young woman regain her independence as she continues to pursue God’s call on her life.

In Thailand, we launched the first nationwide Victim Identification Task Force, welcomed our first survivors into the TTF Protection Center, where elevated protection and holistic care is provided for those seeking justice against their abuser; and we opened a survivor care campus in one of the largest epicenters of trafficking and exploitation in the world.

In Uganda, we opened two new gender-based violence shelters providing medical care, counseling, and legal help to those in need.

## RENEWED HOPE: A LEGISLATIVE STAND AGAINST CHILD EXPLOITATION

As an act to champion legislative change, we stood together with bipartisan congressional leaders in Washington, D.C., to introduce the Renewed Hope Act. This bill will create and equip an army of analysts, investigators, and forensic specialists to find and safeguard the more than 50,000 children who have been seen in sexually abusive images by law enforcement but have not been protected yet.

**“FOR TOO LONG, HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF GIRLS AND BOYS HAVE ENDURED HORRIFIC ABUSE — OFTEN AT THE HANDS OF ADULTS WHO ARE SUPPOSED TO PROTECT THEM,” SAID TIM TEBOW. “CHILDREN IN OUR NATION ARE RIGHT NOW LIVING IN THE DARKEST OF EVILS, CRYING OUT FOR HELP. THIS IS WHY WE’RE CALLING ON CONGRESS TO PASS LEGISLATION TO STRENGTHEN OUR NATION’S RESPONSE TO IDENTIFYING AND RESCUING THESE BOYS AND GIRLS.”**

The Renewed Hope Act will enhance Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) capabilities by hiring, training, and assigning at least 200 investigators, computer forensics, and victim identification specialists to the Child Exploitation Investigations Unit and HSI field offices. It will also authorize training in new and advanced victim identification technology to ICE personnel, as well as federal, state, local, military, and foreign law enforcement.

# Orphan Care+ Prevention

Over the past year, we have stood in the gap for orphans, vulnerable young adults aging out of the child welfare system, single mothers, and refugees — across seven countries — offering not just temporary aid, but long-term hope for each one of these lives. The last year has been a testament to your faithfulness and God's goodness. Through prayer, partnerships, and action we have been able to spread the love of God by building and fostering strong families and community.

We reached a major milestone by helping our **400<sup>TH</sup> FAMILY** adopt a child with special needs internationally.

In Poland, nearly **3,200 VULNERABLE PEOPLE** received shelter, counseling, and the care they needed to begin healing from the invasion in Ukraine.

In South Africa, we opened our **5<sup>TH</sup> TTF PROMISE HOME** to care for abandoned babies, welcomed the first students to the TTF Impact Campus, and provided critical support to more than **200,000 PREGNANT WOMEN.**

At House of Hope, in Colombia, we provided holistic care to **26 YOUNG WOMEN** who have aged out of the child welfare system.

At House of Hope, in Ethiopia, **57 GIRLS** were reunited with their families after living on the streets, and we opened the first home for boys.

We also launched Hope Community Centers to provide critical resources for children and their caregivers in Ethiopia and the Philippines.

In Haiti, we added our **12<sup>TH</sup> FAITH, HOPE AND LOVE HOME** providing orphans and children with special needs with a family and the wraparound care they need to thrive.

ROOM FOR MOORE:  
A FAMILY'S INCREDIBLE  
ADOPTION STORY

CALIFORNIA, USA

For Ben and Kirsten Moore, adoption wasn't a backup plan; adoption was the plan—the way they believed God wanted to grow their family.

The Moores brought their first son, Joshua Zhou ("Jo"), home from China in 2016. "They gave him to me for the first time... He gave us this little smile, and it was just game over," Kirsten said. One year later, they adopted Evelyn Yi, a baby girl with a cancerous tumor in her eye. "We didn't know what cancer was going to look like for her... all we knew was that she lost an eye and that she had remaining tumors in her other eye," Ben explained. Nonetheless, they answered God's call and brought Evelyn home and into their family fold.

With each adoption came a deeper walk in faith. With each child, God was asking for a bigger act of trust.

When their third adoption process in China stalled due to the pandemic, Kirsten asked God for direction. Then, in June 2021, an email arrived titled: "Little boy." It was about a child named Chung Hei from Hong Kong, a 5-year-old little boy with a severe heart condition. Though fearful of his condition, they moved forward.

When filming their story last year, Kirsten explained "We had no good reason to say no; we just didn't," Kirsten explained. "God gives you everything you need in that moment... every day, it's like, here's your daily bread; now go keep going."



After arriving home in June 2023, they began navigating life with new diagnoses—including 13 heart anomalies. Despite it all, Chung Hei is full of energy and love. "You take your eyes off him for a second, he'll be on the roof with something!" Kirsten laughed.

Thanks to you, our generous TTF giving family, we were able to come alongside the beautiful Moore family as they embraced God's call to be Chung Hei's family.

## SEBASTIAN: A CHILD WORTH FIGHTING FOR

One day, Anastasia received a phone call that changed her life forever. Her great nephew, Sebastian, and his mother had been in a horrific car accident in Guatemala and were rushed to the hospital.

Anastasia immediately broke the news to her entire family, including Sebastian's dad, Brian. Brian rushed to the hospital to see his child, only to find out even more devastating news. Sebastian had been declared brain dead. Brian was faced with the heartbreaking reality that Sebastian was probably not going to survive. However, he diligently waited by his side and cared for him while Sebastian endured a coma that lasted two days.

In what seemed like a hopeless situation for Sebastian, God showed up and performed a miracle no one could explain. Against all odds, Sebastian regained consciousness from his coma. "The doctors explained he was hanging between life and death. When Sebastian finally woke up, they described it as a miracle from God. They pointed out that many children in similar accidents don't survive. The doctors credited God for Sebastian's resilience," shared Anastasia.

Brian approached Anastasia with a request: to take Sebastian into her care. Without a moment's hesitation, she wholeheartedly said, "Yes." While she sold fruits and vegetables at the market, Sebastian would patiently wait inside a vegetable crate. Anastasia tried her best to take Sebastian to the hospital for therapy, often walking miles carrying him on her back. However, she was still not able to meet all of Sebastian's needs.

One day, a woman noticed Sebastian inside the crate at the market and recommended Anastasia to Tebow Down Guatemala (TDG). Anastasia and Sebastian were welcomed with open arms at Tebow Down Guatemala, a ministry of the Tim Tebow Foundation. "I was happy when I received a call [from Tebow Down Guatemala] because Sebastian needs a lot of therapy. When we first went there, he couldn't do anything. Sebastian couldn't sit [independently], now, he can!" said Anastasia.

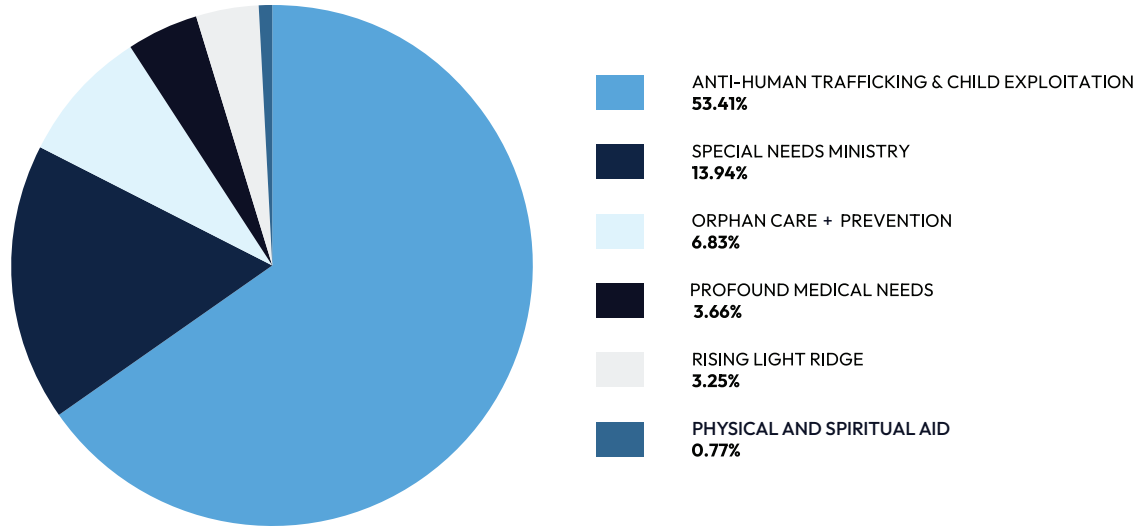
